### **Daraya Activists: 'Truce at Stake in Daraya'**

Activists from the Syrian town of Daraya (available for interview) report that five artillery shells hit the southern part of the town this morning despite the city's complete adherence to the truce which has been in place since 28 February.

This breach of the truce, attributed to the Assad regime, comes after the regime stopped a medical aid convoy from entering the city on 12 May because it contained 'baby milk'.

Daraya has been under siege since 2012 and has faced heavy aerial bombardment by the Assad regime, sometimes dozens of barrel bombs per day.

Activists from Daraya are available for interview to comment on the latest developments.
